



Humber Bridge TrailO Weekend

20-21 September 2025

A rare opportunity to try a weekend of Trail Orienteering either side of the Humber Bridge. Both events are within 2km of the Humber Bridge – one to the North and one to the South!

Saturday 20 September: Baysgarth Park, Barton-Upon-Humber
Sunday 21 September: Humber Bridge Country Park, Hesse

Both venues are accessible by public transport - train to Hull interchange and bus to/over the Humber Bridge. The two venues are very different both offering interesting courses which incorporate different disciplines. Both have good tracks suitable for wheelchairs and are slightly undulating with no steep hills. An SI dibber is needed for both start and finish (*it can be hired*). The answers are to be recorded using a needle punch on a control card supplied. As these are British TrailO League (BriTOL) events, entry is for individuals only (no group entry) as discussion on the courses is not allowed.

Saturday 20th September: Baysgarth Park, Barton-upon-Humber

Start times: 13.00 – 14.00 You can choose to do either course first but you must do the TempO by 14.00.

Courses: The terrain is parkland with distinctive trees and many manmade features. We are offering both a timed sprint event of 12 controls and a 3 station TempO event with 4 stations. Results will be based on total time for sprint and TempO courses, with total correct and then fastest time (with a time penalty for wrong answers). New updated map 1:3000 with 2.5m contours.

Sunday 21st September: Humber Bridge Country Park, Hesse.

Planner: Ricardo Telmo Fernandes (HALO), adviser Iain Phillips (LEI)

Start times: 11.00 – 12.00 ; On day 1

Course: The area is an old chalk quarry surrounded by high cliffs with complex vegetation. There will be a PreO course with 20 locations followed by time controls (with time penalty for wrong answers). Results will be based on the total correct then the fastest time. New map 1:3000 with 5m contours.

Entries: Enter at racesignup.co.uk. **Fees:** Senior over 21 £10 per day or £18 for weekend. Non BOF members extra £2 each day. Junior under 21 £5 per day or £9 for weekend. To guarantee a map enter by 23.59 on **Sunday 14th September**. Entries can be made right up to the event online subject to available maps. Start times will not be allocated.

For beginners, this weekend will be a great opportunity to discover Trail Orienteering - it will be a great test of your map reading skills! To find out more about TrailO and to prepare for the events, see:
